Wilson, Wyoming – Nineteen raptor species soar against the backdrop of the Tetons amongst other creatures of the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem on the one-of-a-kind Raptor Quilt. Textile artist Elli Sorensen sewed and hand painted this silk quilt over a two-month period in her New Mexico studio, inspired by her many years in the Tetons and her love of Teton Raptor Center and the wildlife they support.

Elli Sorensen said, "I've chosen to make my small mark on the world with art quilts; by engaging with small nonprofit organizations who raise awareness and protect the wild places and their inhabitants who are our neighbors on this beautiful planet."

The quilt measures 4'10" x 7'8" and raffle tickets are \$10 each or 12 for \$100.
